

VILLAGE OF CLAYVILLE
LOCAL LAW #1/CALENDAR YEAR 2018
USER FEES FOR TRASH AND GARBAGE COLLECTION
NOVEMBER 8, 2018

Collection of user fees for trash and garbage collection in the Village of Clayville.

By adoption herein, the Village of Clayville Board of Trustees hereby repeal in totality, Local Law No. 1 of 1990 and Local Law No. 2 of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Village of Clayville contracts periodically for the collection of trash and garbage throughout the Village limits by a private contractor at a specified contract price, apportioned over the term of said contract;

WHEREAS, the continued health, welfare, and safety of the Village requires that a user fee, and ad valorem tax, and trash tax collection be collected from each recipient of said public service: it is now, therefore

ENACTED by the Boar of Trustees of the Village of Clayville:

1. That each recipient of said service shall pay a user fee, as adopted and adjusted annually by the Village Board of Trustees; and
2. Said fee shall be billed on a quarterly basis to each said recipient; and
3. The Village Board of Trustees is hereby authorized and empowered to assess an ad valorem charge against any real property parcel not otherwise contributing a user fee hereunder; and
4. That any such user fee of ad valorem tax remaining unpaid at the conclusion of each fiscal year shall constitute a lien upon the subject real

5. property parcel served and/or benefitting from said service, and shall appear on the next village real property tax bill as a separate line item; an administrative relevy fee of 5% of the delinquent account may be assessed and added thereto; and

6. That each such user fee and/or ad valorem tax shall be due and payable within thirty (30) days of mailing by the village clerk, and thereafter shall bear interest at the regular legal note.

7. The foregoing provisions shall take effect thirty days following the date this local law is filed with the New York State Secretary of State.

Conflicts and Separability

- A. CONFLICTS: All local laws of parts of local laws in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
- B. SEPARABILITY: The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence or provision of this local law shall not affect the validity of any other part of this local law, which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.

Local Law In Force

This local law shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, recording and publication, thirty (30) days following receipt for filing by the New York State Department of State.
